Positions Consider training hand signals, as well as words. The dog should be able to assume any position from any other position.							
<b>Heeling</b> Continue to work on this. You should begin to be able to tolerate some distractions.							
Eye Contact Vary your position in relation to the dog & begin to use mild distractions.							
Meet & Greet a Friend Continue to work on this.							
Recalls to the Collar  Do this a half dozen time randomly throughout the day. First, touch collar, then say "good", then give the treat.							
Stays Coax the dog into holding a sit or a down for 5-15 sec (or less). Try for 2 sessions of 2-3 trials per day.							
Finishes (getting the dog to your side) Swing Finish - dog in front, treat in left hand, step back w/ left foot & lure dog into position @ your left side. Parade Finish - dog in front, treat in each hand, lure dog around you w/ right hand, then continue w/ left hand to get dog to left side.
