<b>Positions</b> Continue to work these. Try to have the dog assume the position when you are sitting in a chair or are a few steps away.							
<b>Heeling</b> Continue working on this. Try to get in the habit of doing the same routine each time you cross a (real or make believe) intersection.							
<b>Eye Contact</b> Gradually continue to increase duration & amount/kind of distractions.							
<b>Meet &amp; Greet a Friend</b> Continue to work on this & expect more from the dog.							
<b>Recalls to the Collar</b> Work <b>Random</b> as well as <b>Restrained</b> Recalls.							
<b>Stays</b> Gradually lengthen durations & begin to take a step or two away from the dog. Always return to the dog & praise/treat at the end (before releasing the dog).							
<b>Finishes</b> Work both the <b>Swing</b> & <b>Parade</b> Finishes. To make this easier, you might teach the dog to come in front of you as well.							
<b>Honoring</b> (or " <i>Leave it</i> ") We will discuss this in more detail in class.							
<b>A Trick</b> Continue working for next week.
